González Byass, Alfonso, Oloroso Seco 18% £3.20 £6.40
Alfonso is a delicious, dry Oloroso with a deep mahogany colour, warm spicy aromas & pronounced nutty flavours

Gonzalez Byass, Leonor, Palo Cortado 20% £3.50 £7.00
Leonor is best described as medium dry: Amontillado on the nose, Oloroso in the mouth. A stunning amber colour with hints of orange, this wine has fine aromas of wood, vanilla & almonds

Jerez Fino Romate 15% £2.95 £5.90
Dry, fragrant & delicate with fresh green apple aromas. It can be drunk at any time of day & is especially suitable as an aperitif

Pedro Ximenez 16% £3.20 £6.40
Richly sweet, thick & sumptuous dessert sherry with sweet figgy, raisin & toasty flavours
